ABOUT FRASER VALLEY YOUTH SOCIETY (FYVS)

The Fraser Valley Youth Society (FVYS) is a not for profit, organization that provides LGBTQ2S+, allied, and at risk youth with opportunities for personal growth and leadership through workshops, programs and community connections.

We operate weekly drop-in centres (Abbotsford, Mission and Chilliwack), as well as other special events and programs throughout the year. This is a safe and inclusive space for youth to be among their peers and talk about issues they are facing. We also provide LGBTQ2S+ presentations to those interested in learning more about terminology and how to support this Community.

We believe a positive, inclusive and safe environment for these youth is very important and a safe, happy and healthy community is needed for them to grow up in. You can help to make a difference and remove the barriers for our youth!

HOW TO SET UP A FESTIVAL BOOTH...

FESTIVAL BOOTH SPACE

The Fraser Valley Pride Festival Manager will assign you a 10x10 space. Festival Booth Vendors are encouraged to bring their own tent or booth structure as long as it fits within the 10x10 space you have applied for and does not exceed 15' in height.

You are responsible for your own table and chairs. All booths are assigned based on the space available. Please note, there ARE NO PEGGING or SPIKING of TENTS ALLOWED on the grounds. Sandbags or other means must hold down all tents.

If you need table and chairs they can be provided at an extra cost. \$10 for a table and \$5 per chair. We would need to know by June 15th in order to accommodate this request. Please no late requests.

FESTIVAL BOOTH SET UP

Fraser Valley Pride Festival setup starts on Saturday July 14th at 9:00AM. Set-up completion, including removal of all non-essential vehicles, must be completed by 11:30 AM sharp! Contact the Operations Coordinator at info.fvpride@gmail.com – prior to event day if you have any questions or special requests.

TEAR DOWN

Festival Booth Vendors are required to remain until festival ending, NO EXCEPTIONS. Festival site tear down cannot commence sooner than 4pm on July 14, 2018. Festival Booth Vendors spaces must be returned to their original condition. This includes the removal of any and all garbage and recycling used in your displays.

No vehicles are permitted on-site for tear down until 4 pm. Each Festival Booth must check out with our on-site Fraser Valley Pride Festival Operations Coordinator to ensure the safe return of all equipment & cleanliness of the site itself.

FESTIVAL ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

We take Pride in our environment. With the increasing global focus on environmental sustainability we are committed to minimizing our impact at Fraser Valley Pride. We ask that you leave the site the way you found it. Garbage, recycling, bottles are to be disposed of in the appropriate containers.

ELECTRICAL

Electricity may be available for Festival Booths and needs to be indicated on your Festival Booth application. We will advise if we are able to supply. You may bring a generator. All generators must be registered for the event with your registration. Generators must be operated on the outer lying booths only in order to avoid noise intrusion and to vent exhaust away from other festival booths. Note: power requests and generators must be noted on your application form. No late requests to bring a generator.

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SOUND

No broadcasting will be allowed on any booth site other than from battery powered, portable, domestic-use radio/CD/DVD/iPod units. Sound must not interfere with any neighbouring booths or the main stage area. If you will have sound please indicate on your application.

ALCOHOL AND ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

Alcoholic beverages and all illegal substances are not permitted within the event area. If you are found to be in possession of such items, you will be asked to leave the event site immediately. NO EXCEPTION!

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application deadline for all Fraser Valley Pride Festival 2018 vendors is June 15th, 2018 and MUST include application, payment and signed agreement. Applications are accepted on a first come first come first served basis. Late applications may be denied if space is unavailable. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and suggest you get your application to us as early as you can.

Applications received AFTER June 15th, may not be accepted and must be approved by the Pride Planning Committee.
